# **MORNING STUDY & WORK PROGRAMME** (20 HOURS PER WEEK)

#### Course Aim

To help students develop their general English speaking, reading, writing and listening skills so they can live, work, study and travel successfully in the English speaking world.

## **Course Description**

This course is for students studying for 25 weeks for 20 hours per week in morning classes. It is open to all levels and on completion of this course students take one of the following internationally recognised exams, please see the list below.

On arrival, students are placed in the appropriate level of General English classes according to their placement test. During the first week, students have a special induction meeting with a member of staff to discuss their course and which exam they will take at the end of their stay.
